Principal Update (Teresa)

Monthly review:

- 188 students registered
- 9 remote learners
- Brittany Walker is back next year in 0.3 French (2 classes) and also teaching remote learning for 0.5 (half a day)
- New TV to replace Smart board in Kindergarten Rm. 8 already one in Rm. 7
- Ordered a new TV for Gr. 2/3 in Rm. 1 hoping for install soon but very backed up
- Fire drills happening (just did one Friday and need to do 2 more) will may do a lockdown drill as well
- Intramurals happening baseball for Gr. 3-6 at recess
- Dance club also happening
- Extra help for flute players from Miranda (custodian and student monitor)
- Instrumental music/band for grade 6s

- Math – number sense and operations -focus on subtraction and teaching students how to use the open number line as a tool for subtraction

- Literacy OHRC Right to Read inquiry report reading is a human right
- Board goal 90% students will read at grade level

- Focus on phonemic awareness (oral) and phonics (written) – renewed focus on explicit instruction using a specific scope and sequence for teaching this from JK right through to Gr. 6. Research shows a shift in practice need to occur away from using predictable texts and using decodable texts instead.

- Data indicates that many of our students do not have mastery of phonemes, graphemes letter/sound correspondence which is impacting both their reading and spelling.
